CONTRACT Rider -Saturday Night Coin Casino Night

The following additional conditions and terms are to be met:

1. Hospitality: The Purchaser agrees to provide refreshments such as soda, juice, or coffee; candy, fruit, Dinner or snacks are greatly appreciated.
2. Operators: professional operators can only be provided for non-fund raising events and are licensed, insured, and wear tuxedos for your event. If volunteer operators are to be used, they must arrive at least one hour before your event to be trained.
3. Accessories: all basic accessories such as cards, dice, signs, chips, etc. to operate games are included in the contract price. Items not included are chairs, banquet tables, ashtrays and other items normally provided by establishments catering to functions of this type.
4. Manager: For events of 100 people and above, a casino manager is provided at no cost.
5. Damages: the PURCHASER agrees to assume financial responsibility for damage to ARTIST'S equipment caused by vandalism or other malicious acts. The amount of compensation for damage resulting from such acts will be determined by negotiation between the PURCHASER and the ARTIST after reviewing competitive bids submitted by the PURCHASER and/or ARTIST.
6. Accommodations (# of Rooms): 1 for 2 person(s) for 1 night in a Radisson, Holiday Inn or Marriott or similar national hotel chain with credit card dial access for telephone calls. If no appropriate accommodations are available a \$100.00 hotel allowance will be added to the agreed price.

YOU MUST PROVIDE:

11-14 volunteer operators, available for training 1hr. before event

1 banquet table

At least 20 chairs

A first floor Facility (or easy access to freight sized elevator)*

100 plastic cups for carrying around chips & tokens

4 strong Volunteers to assist with load-in

Available 2 hours prior to event, and load out (@ 1 hour after event)

OPTION: We suggest the use of more tables and chairs around the perimeter of the room.
